#### SUPERINTENDENT INTERVIEW QUESTIONS:

- 1. Describe your knowledge of or involvement with school district leadership in the following areas: District visibility, communication skills, school culture, student achievement and alternative schools.
- 2. How many employees do you currently directly supervise? How would your employees classify your leadership style?
- 3. Please tell us about your past experience working with and gathering support for levies, and about your thoughts on working with our Treasurer or others on these types of initiatives. Also, please describe ideas about the ideal superintendent/treasurer relationship.
- 4. What are some of the communications or leadership skills you possess that will help you work with our Board in terms of keeping us fully informed about emerging issues in education and within our district in particular? How do you envision creating a true partnership between the Superintendent's office and the Board of Education?
- 5. Have you had experience in negotiating a collective bargaining agreement? Please describe.
- 6. How do you envision the use of technology for preparing our students for the jobs that have not yet been created?
- 7. Share with us your experience in building support within the community for public education and in particular, how you would go about envisioning and articulating a strategic direction of the Euclid City Schools that allows our constituents to gain confidence in what we are doing?
- 8. What made you apply to lead a school district whose Performance Index is 52.3%. Gap closing annual measurable objective Grade F? What initiatives will you bring to the district that will result in an immediate improvement in district achievement, graduation rate and student preparation for success?
- 9. At our community focus group, citizens expressed the importance of the Superintendent living within the City of Euclid. Have you considered this possibility? It is not a requirement for the position.
- 10. As you know the Board is prohibited from hiring any individual with certain criminal convictions. We will conduct a background check on any final candidate. But we also require all candidates to disclose any criminal history now as part of this interview process, so that we can work through this issue at the outset. And so I ask, have you ever been convicted of a criminal offense other than a minor traffic violation? Is there anything we have not already discussed in your background that could cause embarrassment to the Board or District?
