End of Busing

- You have probably learned that our district will no longer provide transportation to and from school for our high school students. This arrangement begins Wednesday, January 4. We have included in this mailing a map of the parking lot that signals our traffic patterns for drop-off and pick-up. Please note the following:
 - **Entrances:** You can enter our parking lot from either E. 222 or Tracy Ave.
 - **Morning Hours:** Our doors open at 6:15 AM, but students will not have access to the entire school until 7:25 AM. Students must enter school by 7:39 AM or they are considered tardy and will miss their first period class.
 - **Safety:** Please do not stop your car to let your student exit on E. 222 or Tracy.
 - **RTA:** Bus passes are available in our E-Room for \$1.75 each. Route #28 runs up and down E. 222. Schedules are available at www.riderta.com.
 - **After School:** We encourage you to pick your child up on a side street in the vicinity of the school since we envision a very crowded parking lot. Students must depart school by 2:40 PM unless directly supervised by a coach or sponsor of another extra-curricular activity.
 - **Student Parking:** Parking passes are available to all students with drivers' licenses. Students can purchase them from the security office for \$20.

Community Service Honor

- Beginning this June, students will have the opportunity to earn special recognition at Commencement for performing community service both inside and outside our school. Please note the following procedures:
 - 1) Students must perform 20 hours per year of community service to earn recognition. (10 hours is acceptable for the 2011-2012 school year due to the timing of this opportunity.)
 - 2) Community service can be any activity which serves the school, city, or any civic organization. This service must be an activity beyond an actual meeting.
 - 3) A principal should sign indicating that the activity is sufficient to constitute service.
 - 4) An adult sponsoring the actual activity should sign to verify the student's completion of service hours.
 - 5) Students can use the log included in this mailing to chart their hours. Students should obtain new logs each year of their high school career.
 - 6) Graduating seniors must submit their log to Ms. Yolanda Lee by May 1 of their final year.
 - 7) Students meeting the 20 hour threshold will receive special notice in our Commencement program and a cord to recognize their efforts.

We hope that many students will participate in this exciting opportunity!
