

Euclid Schools' Secretaries United Scholarship Criteria

1. Applicant must be a Euclid High School graduating senior.
2. Applicant must have passed all parts of the 10th Grade Ohio Graduation Test at the time of application.
3. Two letters of recommendation are required.
 - ❖ Business Teacher Recommendation
 - ❖ Employer (may be from summer employer)

If you have not taken a business course, the teacher recommendation may be from a Math or English Teacher. Letters of recommendation must be placed in a sealed envelope with recommender's signature across the sealed flap. **Letters from anyone else will not be accepted.**

4. Applicant must be majoring in business or a related field.
5. Applicant must have a minimum 2.7 GPA on a 4.0 scale
6. Submit official transcript in sealed envelope with signature across flap.
7. All school fees must be paid in full at time of application.
8. Applicants who fail to comply with instructions will be disqualified.
9. Do not include any additional attachments.
10. Completed application, transcript and letters of recommendation must be returned to the Attention of Mrs. McRedmond, Fordyce Building, no later than 3:00 P.M. on Thursday. April 15, 2010.
11. Application is to be typed or you may e-mail your request for the application to smcredmond@euclid.k12.oh.us and complete on the computer. In the subject area of your e-mail please put **scholarship application request**.
