Dear Parent/Guardian

This is a letter regarding the School Improvement status of your child's school. Supplemental Educational Services (SES) are offered **FREE** to students who 1) attend a school that is designated by the Ohio Department of Education in School Improvement Year 2 or above; 2) **are on free or reduced lunch**; 3) attend a school receiving federal funds. **Students in grades 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5** are eligible to participate in this program. Student selection is based on highest academic need and is approved only if the funds are available. Your child can receive tutoring services in reading and mathematics.

Students who attend Lincoln, Memorial Park, Roosevelt and Upson Elementary Schools, and meet the above qualifications, are eligible to receive Supplemental Educational Services. If you would like to request these **FREE** services, you can see a list of approved providers for Cuyahoga County at http://webapp1.ode.state.oh.us/provider_proposal/lookup/ or contact your school office.

To help you in your selection of an approved provider, Euclid City Schools will be hosting an **SES Fair on Wednesday, October 12, 2011 at Memorial Park Elementary School from 7:00-8:30 p.m.** At that time SES Providers, approved by the Ohio Department of Education, will be available to provide you with detailed information regarding this **FREE** program. Euclid Schools will hold Open Enrollment from November 1, 2011 until January 31, 2012. Parents should return their completed applications to the school office. Our School District will forward all qualifying applications to the individual SES Providers selected.

When deciding which tutoring program is best for your child, you may want to ask these questions:

- When and where will the tutoring take place (at school, home, or a community center)?
- How often and for how many hours in total will your child be tutored?
- What type of instruction will the tutor use: small group or one-on-one?
- What are the tutors' qualifications?
- Can the tutor help if your child has disabilities or is learning English?
- Is transportation available to and from where the tutoring will take place?

Please fill out the attached 2011-2012 Supplemental Educational Service Sign-Up Notice and return to the school. As a reminder: Student selection is based on highest academic need order and is approved only if the funds are available. Once we receive your request, the SES Provider must enter into an agreement with the Euclid City Schools to complete the process.
