



**TO ALL EUCLID PARENTS WHO HAVE STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS
AND ARE ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT.**

Dear Parents:

Beginning this school year, parent reimbursement will be made according to the minimum amount allowed by the State Department of Education, which is \$538.55. The payment will be mailed in July, 2022. For students that move during the school year, those families will not be entitled to the full reimbursement.

In order to qualify for parent reimbursement, the regulations set up by the State Department of Education use the following guidelines:

1. The school must be a chartered school in the State of Ohio.
2. A student in grades K-8 must live more than 2 miles from his/her school.
3. A student in grades 6, 7, & 8 must live more than 2 miles from the school.
4. **NO HIGH SCHOOL REIMBURSEMENT.**
5. The traveling time to your child's school must not be more than 30 minutes.

Please complete and return the enclosed application form to the Euclid Board of Education, by October 31, 2021. We must have a signed form for **each** student for whom you are requesting reimbursement.
