



1:1 DEVICE AGREEMENT

In this agreement, "you" and "your" refers to the parent/guardian and the student enrolled in the Euclid City School District [ECSD]. The "device" refers to an iPad for students in grades K-5, and a Chromebook for students in grades 6-12.

The Euclid City School District will be supplying students in grades KG-5 with an Apple iPad, and students in grades 6-12 with a Lenovo Chromebook. This device will be the property of the district. The supplied device will provide each student access to educational materials needed for achievement during the school year, and will allow student access to G Suite for Education (formerly Google Apps for Education), Infinite Campus and other web-based educational tools required by the curriculum. The device is an educational tool and not intended for gaming, social media/networking or high end computing.

Terms of Agreement:

- You and your child will comply with the Acceptable Use Policy and Internet Safety Agreement [Board policy 7540.03]. Violations of the policy will result in revocation of network access privileges, suspension of access to ECSD electronic resources, other school disciplinary action, and/or other appropriate legal or criminal action including restitution.
- Students are responsible for the general care of their device. Devices that are broken, damaged, or otherwise fail to work, should be entered into the designated districts repair process.
- Students, Parents and/or Guardians will be held financially accountable for lost, stolen, or damaged devices. Financial obligations will not exceed the District's cost to repair or replace the technology.
- To help cover the costs of repair, you will be charged an annual fee of \$20 which should be paid in advance of receiving a device. This will cover the cost of the device's first repair. After this first repair, all other repairs to the device will be at the parent's expense and will be automatically added to the student's school fees. Fees for repairs will be in accordance with the 1:1 Device Fee Schedule.
- You must report any lost, stolen, or damaged equipment to the school immediately. For stolen equipment, a police report is required. If the equipment is not returned or returned damaged, either intentionally or due to negligence, the student will be subject to discipline and the adult will be responsible for the cost of repair or replacement [Board policy 6152].
- The device remains the property of Euclid City Schools. Activity is logged, filtered, and monitored as required by CIPA. No web-filtering product is foolproof, or is as impactful as a conversation between a student and their parent/guardian over internet Safety and the expectations of behavior while online.
- The district reserves the right to evaluate and implement any options that ensure student safety and proper educational usage.
- Students, Parents and/or Guardians are not permitted to logon to the device with credentials other than the district provided username and password. Only the student assigned to the device may use the issued device.
- No one other than district authorized personnel may alter any software configurations or settings.
- Students are expected to bring the device back completely charged. Charge the device every night.
